Streetscape Phase II (TE Sidewalk II)	\$700,000	\$175,000	Construction of approximately 1 mile of sidewalk along Highway 29/Roosevelt Highway, State Route 138. Also addresses sidewalk gap along Lester Road.
Highpoint Bridge and Sidewalks	\$250,000	\$75,000	Construction of a 110' long pedestrian bridge over a creek on Highpoint Road to provide safety and connectivity for residents. This project is complete.
Union City Pedestrian System -- Phase I	\$500,000	\$125,000	Provides connectivity to adjacent arterial streets on the Dodson Road, College Street, Union Street and Baker Street.
Union City Pedestrian System -- Phase III	\$350,000	\$87,500	Provides connectivity to adjacent arterial streets on Lakeside Drive, Oakley Road and Shannon Boulevard.
Buffington Road Bridge Replacement	\$1,700,000	\$0.00	Provides for a bridge replacement on Buffington Road over Morning Creek.
Energy Efficiency Conservation Block Grant (EECBG)	\$157,500	\$0.00	Project scope included the retrofitting of new lights at City Hall and South Fulton Municipal Jail. This project is complete.
Justice Assistance Grant (ARRA) Award	\$73,150.73	\$0.00	Funding allocated to the purchase of patrol cars and related emergency equipment for the police department.
Justice Assistance Grant (Local Share) Award	\$24,376	\$0.00	Funding utilized to purchase a patrol car for the Union City Police Department.
COPS Hiring Grant	\$496,863		Supported the hiring of three police officers; Funding covers salary plus benefits.
Assistance for Fire Grant	\$77,650	\$4,085.00	Funding supported the purchase of bunker gear for the fire department

Community Development Block Grant 2010	\$50,000	\$0.00	Project scope included updating the piping structure for the gutter, storm and drainage system located at the block of 4700-4800 Church Street. This project is complete.
Community Development Block Grant 2011	\$56,690	\$0.00	Installation of approximately 880 linear feet of 8 inch and 6 inch water main and abandonment of an existing 2 inch water line along McKinley Avenue and Haven Street. This project is complete.
Community Development Block Grant 2012	\$53,750	\$0.00	Project consisted of demolition, retaining wall construction, surface drainage improvements and storm drainage improvements. This project is complete.
Community Development Block Grant 2013	\$53,750	\$0.00	Shannon Boulevard Drainage Improvements Project- Includes replacing a 52" corrugated metal pipe with a 54" concrete pipe that runs across the street in front of the Windham Creek Subdivision. Approximately 100 feet of pipe will be replaced along with a new headwall and rip rap.
Community Development Block Grant 2014	\$53,750	\$0.00	Replacement of a 2" water line with a 8" water line from Roosevelt Highway and Gresham Road to Roosevelt Highway and Thompson Road.

Local Maintenance Improvement Grant 2011	\$20,481	\$0.00	Project scope consisted of the paving Jamaica Court and Pine Valley Road. This project is complete.
Local Maintenance Improvement Grant 2012	\$60,691	\$0.00	Project consisted of paving Ravenwood Drive, Ravenwood Loop, and Enclave Drive located in Ravenwood Subdivision. This project is complete.
Local Maintenance Improvement Grant 2013	\$134,731	\$40,420	Mill and inlay of Hunter Road from Roosevelt Highway to South Fulton Parkway.
Recreational Trails Grant	\$100,000	\$30,865	Walking trail system established at Ronald Bridges Park; The trail includes signage and culminates into a new community amenity. This project is complete.
Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ)	\$629,235	\$110,275	Project scope consists of sidewalk construction along Shannon Parkway from Jonesboro Road to Mall Boulevard. Revision includes pipe repair.
