

## Union City Community Development Department



### REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION PERMITS

- 1. Sites over 1.1 acre should submit three (3) sets of site plans and sites under 1.1 acres should submit five (5) sets of site plans, including water and sewer plans, and if applicable, three (3) sets of grease trap plans, two (2) Hydrological Report, one (1) copy of the completed Section 404 Acknowledgement and Certification Form, Engineer's Certificate on Flood Plains and Storm Water Run-off, \$200 review fee (made payable to City of Union City) and the Site Plan Review Application.
  - 200 review fee (made payable to City of Union City) and the Site Plan Review Application. Plans are accepted Tuesday through Friday and are delivered to the consulting City Engineer's office on Mondays. Project Managers may choose to deliver plans/documents directly to the City Engineer (Keck and Wood Engineering, Inc.). All fees must be provided to the City of Union City before transporting plans/documents to Keck and Wood. Contact Information for the City Engineer is below:

- Each revision fee is \$200.00. Please provide this fee, each time additional information is submitted to the City Engineer for additional review of information.
- As of January 1, 2007 the design professional should place a note on the plans near the seal and signature indicating their GSWCC Level 2 certification number and expiration date.
- Plans may be submitted electronically in AutoCad .dwg files are preferred.
- Plans for all water line extensions over eight (8) inches must be submitted to State Department of Environmental Protection Agency for review and approval
- 2. If development site is over 1.1 acre, submit site plans, and a copy of the Hydrological Study to the Georgia Soil and Water Conservation Commission. Two (2) copies of approved erosion and sediment control plans should be returned to the City. Please address any questions to the following:

Permits are required for all structural work, including but not limited to addition or removal of walls or ceilings, as well as for any electrical, HVAC and plumbing work done on existing buildings. Cosmetic work, including but not limited to painting, carpet installation and cleaning does not require a permit. The City does require that before any cosmetic work is begun that a typed letter be submitted summarizing all work to be done and includes contact information for the individual responsible for the work.

4. Submit four (4) sets of Building Construction Plans, including all related NFPA requirements, to the City of Union City Inspections Department for review and approval by the Building Inspector and Fire Marshal. The Construction Review Fee for the Building Inspector for residential building plans is \$100 per house plan and for commercial is based on contract amount. Permit valuations shall include total cost, such as electrical, gas, mechanical, plumbing equipment and other systems, including materials and labor. The City currently is under the 2006 ICC Codes with Georgia Amendments. The Fire Marshal will invoice you for his review. Address any questions to:

- 5. If development is a subdivision or fee-simple townhouse complex, developer must submit cash, cashier's check or money order to be deposited in an escrow account to guarantee faithful performance by the subdivider or developer of work required to complete all improvements and installation for associated with development of the subdivision, or unit division thereof. Reference the Inspection Fee form for amount due.
- 6. For Health Department approval submit the following to:

- ☑ Three (3) sets of site plans for dumpster pad and drainage
- ☑ Three (3) sets of construction plans if proposed project is a food service facility
- ☑ Three (3) sets of construction plans for public swimming pools
- ☑ Non-sewered toilet permits are required on all construction sites and special events.
- ☑ Septic tank approval required submission of percolation test to Health Department for issuance of permit.
- 6. If property abuts any part of a State highway system, submit two (2) copies of the proposed development site plans to:

# Upon receipt by the City of a copy of approved plans listed above, the following may be obtained at the Permits Department located in City Hall

1. Land Disturbance Permit – Fee is \$150 for the first two disturbed acres and an additional \$100 for each portion of an acre thereafter. Prior to issuance of a land disturbance permit for all projects NPDES fees in the amount of \$40 per disturbed acre must be paid and a Soil Erosion & Sediment Control Cash Deposit in form of cash, cashier's check or money order to be deposited in an escrow account in the amount of \$3,000 per acre or portion of acre is required. Residential developments are also required to submit Inspection Fees and a Performance Cash Deposit (refer to Inspection Fee Worksheet for amounts).

No work may commence on a site until Pre-Construction meeting has been held with Public Services – Code Enforcement Division. Questions regarding the pre-construction meeting should be directed to:

- 2. Building Permit, Electrical, HVAC, Plumbing Permits
  - a.) One and Two Family Residential Permit
    - New Construction Combination Permit = \$0.25 per square foot, minimum permit fee is \$300
    - Additions/Renovations \$3.00 per \$1,000 of construction value, minimum fee for each trade = \$50.00
    - Re-inspection fees \$35.00 for first failure of requested inspection, \$50.00 for subsequent failures of requested inspection
  - b.) Multifamily and Commercial Permit
    - New Construction Combination Permit
