

November 2, 2021 Ballot Question (T-SPLOST)

Fulton County voters outside the city of Atlanta will consider renewing the TSPLOST during the November 2, 2021 General Municipal Election. The renewal would maintain the current rate of 0.75 cents. The ballot question will read:

"Shall an additional .75 percent sales tax be collected in that part of Fulton County, Georgia, outside of the City of Atlanta, for five years for the purpose of transportation improvements and congestion reduction?"



2021 T-SPLOST RENEWAL

- If approved by voters, the TSPLOST Renewal will generate \$545 million from 2022 to 2027.
- Funding will be allocated to each participating city based on 2019 population.
- Union City would receive \$20.4 million for transportation infrastructure.
- Funds will continue to be managed locally to fund the identified projects.
- TSPLOST Projects have improved safety, reduced congestion, and enhanced quality of life across Fulton County.





T-SPLOST FUNDING - FULTON COUNTY

Projects on the 2022 TSPLOST Project List include over \$545 million in transportation infrastructure investments over the next 5 years across North and South Fulton. Project categories include:

- \$177 Million for Pedestrian, Bike, Streetscape & Landscape Projects
- \$82.9 Million for Congestion Relief & Roadway Projects
- \$59.2 Million for Maintenance & Safety Improvements
- \$42.9 Million for Bridges
- \$59.2 Million in Maintenance & Safety Improvements
- \$17.8 Million in Quick Response project funding



T-SPLOST FUNDING - UNION CITY, GA

Projects on the 2022 TSPLOST Project List include over \$20.4 million in transportation infrastructure investments over the next 5 years in Union City. Project categories include:

- \$12.5 Million for Pedestrian, Bike, Streetscape & Landscape Projects
- \$3.5 Million for Operations & Safety Improvements
- \$3.5 Million for Maintenance & Safety Improvements
- \$2 Million for Congestion Relief & Roadway Projects
- \$961,184 for Program Management
- \$500,000 in Quick Response Project Funding
