Request to increase the maximum height requirements for residential community signage.

Mr. Ungaro gave the Staff report detailing Applicant's request to gain relief from the requirement for signage in residential areas to be a maximum of six feet in height. Mr. Bullock requested a maximum of eight feet in height for architectural elements of his proposed sign. Mr. Ungaro stated that Staff would support the approval of the request.
