To amend Article XIII, pertaining to "Zoning Board of Appeals", to eliminate the Zoning Board of Appeals and transfer jurisdiction over appeals, variances and related matters to the Planning Commission, to revise provisions pertaining to notice of public hearings on such matters, to revise provisions pertaining to appeals of decisions of the Planning Commission on such matters, and to make minor changes to grammar and syntax; and
  - 4. To amend Article XV, pertaining to "Planning Commission, Amendment", to make changes consistent with the transfer of jurisdiction over appeals, variances and related matters to the Planning Commission, to revise provisions pertaining to rules and procedures for the Planning Commission, to add language pertaining to disclosures of campaign contributions, to add language pertaining to appeals of decisions of the mayor and council regarding text amendments and map amendments, and to make minor changes to grammar and syntax. (*Planning Commission Recommends Approval*)
