

Redistricting Facts for Fulton County Voters

Why is redistricting conducted?

The purpose of redistricting is to ensure that populations of districts are equitable. This is sometimes referred to as “one person, one vote.”

Who sets district boundaries?

- District boundaries are set by the Georgia General Assembly

When is redistricting conducted?

- Redistricting changes that the General Assembly adopted in December 2023 Special Session will take effect for the purposes of the 2024 May Primary Election and 2024 November General Election.

What offices are affected by redistricting?

- Congressional, State Senate and State House districts were affected by 2024 redistricting.

The Secretary of State has set a February 17 deadline for Fulton County to complete redistricting. Impacted Voters should expect to receive updated precinct cards via postal mail by March 31, 2024.
