- The Youth Council Advisory Committee will review applications and conduct interviews
  with shortlisted candidates. Successful candidates will be announced and notifications
  will be displayed on the City's Public Notice board at City Hall (5047 Union Street), on
  the City's website, and through all digital communication channels.
- Youth Council members must also attend mandatory monthly meetings starting on November 14, 2024, and continuing on the second Thursday of each subsequent month. The dates listed here are non-negotiable and Youth Council members must attend for the entire duration of each event or they will be removed from the Council.

#### SCENARIO-BASED TWO PAGE ESSAY PROMPT

**Prompt:** Union City is currently facing a challenge with low youth engagement in its yearround activities. Given Union City's status as one of the fastest-growing cities in the nation, Mayor Vince Williams is committed to ensuring comprehensive participation across all age groups in the city's events. As a member of the Youth Council, you are responsible for developing and implementing strategies to increase peer engagement in future events.

Essay Question: Develop a project aimed at increasing peer engagement in future events. Outline the project's objective, the strategies you would use to plan and implement it. Additionally, describe how you would measure the project's success and address any potential challenges.

#### In your essay, be sure to address the following:

#### **Project Objectives:**

- Please clearly define the primary objectives of the project, such as enhancing peer engagement, increasing event awareness, or introducing new strategies to boost community involvement.
- Outline how these objectives will contribute to increased youth participation in future events.

#### Planning and Implementation:

- Detail the key components of the project, such as public awareness, safety concerns, or collaborations with surrounding cities youth.
- Outline the steps you would take to develop and execute the project, including a timeline, budget considerations, and roles for team members.

#### **Community Engagement:**

- Describe how you plan to engage community members, including youth, police officers, and adults, in the project.
- Discuss strategies for outreach and engagement, such as public forums, surveys, or partnerships with local organizations and schools.

Your essay should be no longer than two pages, single-spaced, and should demonstrate your ability to design an effective project centered on youth, actively engage the community, and address issues that impact young people comprehensively.
